There are 8 repeats plus another column of double meshes and (I am guessing) a double seam (like GP100) ( $20 \times 8$ repeat) +15 (meshes) +5 (seam sts) $=180$ sts
$180 \times 2=360$ sts (making 90 ribs)
Estimated tension = 10 spi (like GP52 Jack Martins) if the gansey is 36 inches.
